Agenda Discussed

The IQAC committee focused its deliberation on five critical areas to advance institutional quality and faculty growth.

Item	Discussion Summary	Resolution
Faculty Career Advancement (CAS)	Status update on pending CAS applications was provided by the coordinator.	Faculty members with pending applications must immediately submit their complete CAS applications through the Samarth Portal . Technical assistance will be provided to facilitate the digital submission.

Infrastructure: E-Studio Development	The college is set to receive digital infrastructure upgrades under the PM-USHA (Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan) scheme.	The roadmap for the establishment of an E-Studio was approved. This facility will be dedicated to producing high-quality e-content and digital lectures to support hybrid learning models.
Quality Feedback Mechanism	Discussion engaged on the process for collecting necessary institutional feedback online from students.	Student feedback sessions are scheduled for the second week of January 2026. The IQAC will be responsible for overseeing the collection online, analysis, and utilization of these responses for academic improvements.
ICT Integration in Pedagogy	The need for hands-on digital literacy training for the student body was emphasized.	A specialized training program will be organized to instruct students on the effective use of Smart Classes and various ICT tools. The objective is to integrate these technologies into the daily teaching-learning environment to enhance engagement.
International Collaboration	The Chairperson proposed an academic event to expand the college's global outreach.	A proposal was finalized for hosting an International Webinar in March 2026. The event will feature collaboration with an IDSA Fellow (Manohar Parrikar Institute for Defence Studies and Analyses, New Delhi) and subject matter experts from Japan.

Chairperson of this meeting, Prof. Mahendra Prakash, highlighted the determination of executing the resolutions, specifically regarding the utilization of PM-USHA funds and organizing the international Seminar (hybrid mode) in March 2026.
