A. Academic Enhancement & Regulatory Compliance

The college has prioritized aligning with national standards and securing federal recognition to unlock future funding.

B. Infrastructure & Digital Transformation

Significant strides were made in modernizing the learning environment, primarily funded through the PM-USHA initiative.

- **Digital Learning Hub: * Smart Classrooms:** Installation is fully complete and operational.
 1. **E-Studio & Seminar Hall:** Construction and technical setup are currently underway to facilitate blended learning.
 2. **Connectivity:** High-speed internet and campus-wide Wi-Fi connectivity have been established.

- **Security & Tech Labs:**

1. Computer laboratories are now fully equipped and ready for student use.
2. Enhanced campus security through the installation of additional CCTV surveillance points.

C. Student Support & Institutional Linkages

The semester focused on holistic development beyond the traditional classroom setting.

- **Career Guidance:** A specialized workshop was organized to provide students with career-oriented insights and soft-skill development.
- **External Collaborations:** Discussions and formalization of Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with nearby professional institutes are ongoing to facilitate exchange programs and vocational training.
- **Academic Events:** The roadmap for National and International seminars is locked for **March and April 2026.**

D. Physical Education & Wellness

Physical infrastructure for sports and health has been fully upgraded during this term.

- **Sports Ground:** Maintenance and leveling of the ground are complete.
- **Gymnasium:** Modernization of the gym facility is finalized, providing students with improved fitness resources.

The Odd Semester 2025–26 has seen a **90% completion rate** for infrastructural goals under PM-USHA. The primary focus for the upcoming Even Semester will be the successful execution of planned seminars and the finalization of the UGC 12(B) recognition.
