- KAPILA Schemes & IPR Infusion:** Following the IPR workshop on March 12, the council successfully identified three promising student-led grassroots product ideas for documentation under Kalam Program for IP Literacy and Awareness (KAPILA).
- Synergistic Academic Integration:** The activities successfully converged with the college's ongoing Skill Development programs, turning regular theoretical assignments into interactive field-specific entrepreneurship mini-projects.

Proposed Action Plan for Next Academic Session: 2026-27

To ensure sustained institutional performance and increase the overall IIC rating star allocation by the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell, the committee has ratified the following strategic pipeline for the upcoming quarter:

- Establishing a dedicated pre-incubation workspace/cell inside the campus infrastructure.

- Organizing an institutional Boot Camp explicitly focused on navigating the financial landscapes for early-stage female-led MSMEs.
