This interaction reinforced the strong bond between the institution and its alumni, who expressed a high level of satisfaction with the overall quality of teaching and the supportive campus atmosphere.

Strategic Feedback for Institutional Growth

The alumnae actively participated in constructive policy brainstorming, offering valuable feedback categorized under the following key domains:

- **Academic Enhancements:** Introduction of job-oriented add-on courses, specialized workshops focusing on competitive examination preparation, and formalized industry-linked skill development modules.
- **Physical and Digital Infrastructure:** Expanding the digital repositories within the central library, adding advanced computing resources, and advancing smart lecture halls to support blended learning models.
- **Mentorship and Career Counseling:** Establishing a structured Alumni-Student Mentorship Network where current students can receive career guidance, placement counseling, and soft skills preparation from working professionals among the alumni.
- **Community and Outreach:** Strengthening institutional outreach through collaborative social initiatives in nearby villages, promoting awareness regarding higher education and digital literacy for women.
